These children are given opportunities to enhance their development as they are incorporated in education systems and take part in extra-curricular activities such as arts and crafts, dance, swimming and music.







Due to their passion and drive to support the less fortunate our firm has gone from second to first place for “excellence in community service”




Running in heels to fight cancer
